1. Pool Schedule:

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday	11:00 AM - 8:00 PM
Thursday.....	11:00 AM - 9:00 PM
Saturday, Sunday.....	10:00 AM - 8:00 PM

The baby pool is available starting at 9:00 AM daily.

A lap lane is reserved for adult lap swimming except during swim practice, swim meets, and holidays.

2. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. Lake Park Swim Club assumes no responsibility for injury or damage resulting from such use.
3. The Pool Manager and staff will regulate the use of the pool and will maintain control of the pool during operating hours.
4. The Pool Rules and Regulations are designed to provide the greatest pleasure and safety for member and their guests. The Pool Manager and staff are given full authority to enforce all swimming regulations and club rules.
5. No one may use the pool unless there is an employed lifeguard or swimming instructor on duty, except as authorized by the Pool Manager. At the beginning and end of the season, there are some hours when the pool is open but there is no lifeguard on duty. During these times, children 14 and under MUST be accompanied by an adult.
6. Lifeguards are responsible for enforcing the pool rules, and their first priority is safety. However, PARENTS ARE EXPECTED TO PERSONALLY SUPERVISE THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES. The responsibility of adults who accompany children to the pool does not cease because a lifeguard is on duty.
7. When arriving at the pool, members must sign in with their membership numbers. When bringing guests, members must follow the guest sign-in procedure and pay any guest fee that applies. It is the responsibility of the member to talk with the Pool Manager or a staff member and to pay the fee.
8. **Guest Policy:** Members are welcome to bring guests at any time provided that they abide by the rules outlined below. The club encourages members to bring guests on Guest Day (Thursday), when the pool is staffed and prepared for guests and special activities.

- Members must accompany their guests at all times. All guests under 8 years old must be accompanied by an ADULT club member at all times.
- All guests are subject to the club's current *Pool Rules and Regulations*.
- Members must sign in their guests upon arrival and must pay the guest fee:

Guest age 3 - adult	\$5 per person per day (except Guest Day) \$3 per person on Guest Day \$15 maximum per day per membership
Guest age 0 - 2 years	No charge
Out-of-town houseguest	No charge
Nanny or babysitter	No charge when caring for the children; must be registered in advance by the parents
Seven-day pass	\$15 per person for seven consecutive days
Season pass for a 16-and-under guest visiting as friend of a pool member	\$100 per person per season; non-transferrable

9. No child under the age of 8 may be left at the pool without direct supervision of a parent or designated responsible adult.
10. A child age 8 or older may be left at the pool without a parent after passing the swim test. (The swim test involves demonstrating to a lifeguard the ability to swim 25 yards without assistance.) Staying at the pool without a parent is a privilege, and a child who fails to behave appropriately may be required by the Pool Manager to leave the pool. A parent must have a current emergency contact number on file at the pool desk before leaving a child at the pool.
11. A child may use the diving board and may swim in the deep-water area after passing the swim test. (The swim test involves demonstrating to a lifeguard the ability to swim 25 yards without assistance.)
12. When the diving boards are open for use, there may be only one person on a board at a time. The swimmer may bounce on the board only once before entering the water. After entering the water, the swimmer must immediately swim to the nearest ladder. There is to be no diving in the direction of either board. Boards are limited to persons weighing up to 250 lbs.
13. The pool slide is limited to children up to 50 pounds. Only one child may be on the board and ladder apparatus at a time. No backward sliding is allowed. An adult must supervise the child unless the child has passed the swim test. (The swim test involves demonstrating to a lifeguard the ability to swim 25 yards without assistance.)
14. No horseplay on club grounds will be tolerated. No dunking, splashing, running, boisterous behavior, or rough play will be allowed in or around the pool. Violators

will be subject to discipline, regardless of age. Repeated violations will be grounds for suspension of membership.

15. There will be a break for Adult Swim for the last 10 minutes of each hour. All persons under the age of 18 will be required to exit the pool for Adult Swim.
16. Swimming aids, noodles, toys, balls, floats, snorkels, flippers, diving rings, or other similar toys must be discussed with the Pool Manager before being used in the main pool. Depending on the situation at the pool at a given time, the Pool Manager may or may not allow the use of these items.
17. CHILDREN WHO ARE NOT POTTY TRAINED MUST WEAR WATERPROOF SWIM DIAPERS when they are in either the main pool or the baby pool.
18. The baby pool is limited to children under the age of 5. ADULTS MUST ACCOMPANY CHILDREN IN THE BABY POOL AT ALL TIMES.
19. Glass containers OF ANY KIND are strictly prohibited in the pool area at all times. Every member is expected to cooperate with this restriction that is a county and state mandate. Failure to follow this pool rule could cause the county to require the club to drain and refill the entire pool. If a member subjects the club to this expense due to having broken this rule, then the member will be responsible for the cost of such drainage and refill cost.
20. All aluminum cans and plastic bottles should be placed in the appropriate recycling containers in the shelter area.
21. Personal audio speakers are not allowed at the pool. Personal headsets are allowed as long as the volume is kept at a reasonable level.
22. Lounges, chairs, and tables are reserved for adults on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays. Benches and hooks along the fence are available for the belongings of youth and adults so that chairs and tables can be free when not actually in use.
23. Parties and gatherings hosted by a member are allowed at the sole discretion of the Events Committee. To allow for scheduling appropriate staff, such events must be arranged at least ten (10) days in advance with the Events Committee:

24. No pets are allowed in the pool area due to Wake County and North Carolina State regulations governing pools.
25. Lost and Found items are collected in the corner of the pool deck near the baby pool. Pool staff makes an effort to return items marked with the owner's name. Periodically, unclaimed Lost and Found items are donated to charitable organizations.
26. Smoking is not allowed on the pool deck but is allowed at the picnic tables in the grassy area between the pool and the tennis courts.

27. Lake Park Swim Club is a private club for its members and their guests. Management reserves the right to refuse entrance or membership to anyone for any reason at any time.

28. Anyone on club property is subject to the rules and policies published here.
